

VILLAGE OF LOS RANCHOS DE ALBUQUERQUE  
ORDINANCE 102

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER AVAILABILITY AS STATED IN VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 81

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF LOS RANCHOS DE ALBUQUERQUE:

WHEREAS, the definition of public sanitary sewer availability as stated in Village Ordinance 81, Section 3 is ambiguous and impracticable;

NOW THEREFORE, the governing body of the Village of Los Ranchos de Albuquerque does hereby amend Ordinance #81, Section 3 to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Private Liquid Waste Systems Prohibited. No person shall install or modify a private liquid waste system or use a private liquid waste system that was installed or modified after public sanitary sewer service has become available. A public sanitary sewer may be considered available to any lot when such lot is within two hundred (200) feet of public sanitary sewer and the slope between the structure to be served by public sanitary sewer and such sewer is adequate to provide drainage without installation of a pumping system.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all provisions and amendments of Ordinance #81 not amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
